Reading strategies



- 1-Skim text:
 - **Titles** (Understand them **PERFECTLY** they introduce the subject)
 - O Subtitles (Understand them too!)
 - **Images** (Find some hints about the text)
 - Word bank / Glossary... (Learn new words before you read)
- 2- Highlight cognates (Scan)
- 3- Highlight words I understand (Scan)
- 4- Now, what do I know about the text? (Infer)
- 5- Read the text and write a few keywords in the margin to remember what each paragraph is about. (*Take notes*)
- 6- Make sure you understand the **task /questions <u>PERFECTLY</u>** (*dictionary*).
- 7- Look for some words from the task / questions, in the text. (scan)

<u>A few tricks:</u>

- a) If the text contains more than one **name**; highlight each name using different colors.
- b) CAPITAL LETTERS in the middle of sentences
 - → Names (a person, a place, a city...)

Words ending with **ED**, OR **ING** are <u>often</u> verbs

work**ed →** work work**ing →** work

- c) Words ending with **LY** <u>often</u> adverbs
 - → Naturally Natural (Naturellement Naturel)
 - → Kindly Kind (gentil gentiment)

Talented readers can highlight words they don't understand and look them up in the dictionary!
